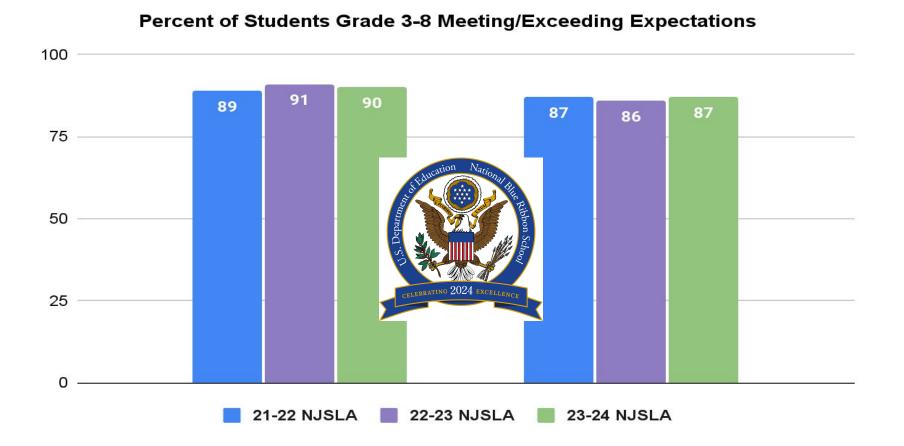


The 2025-2026 Budget supports the realization of student potential by...

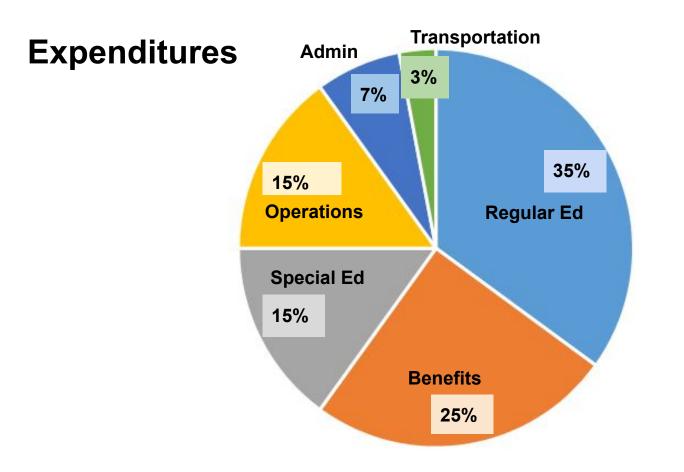

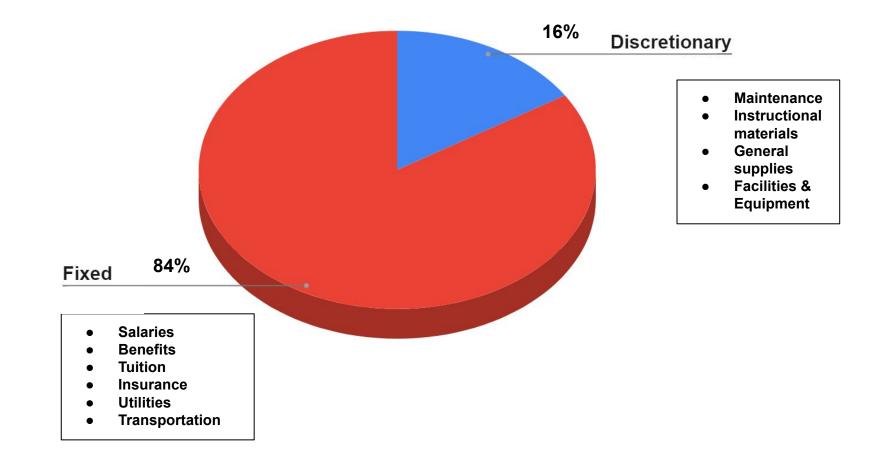

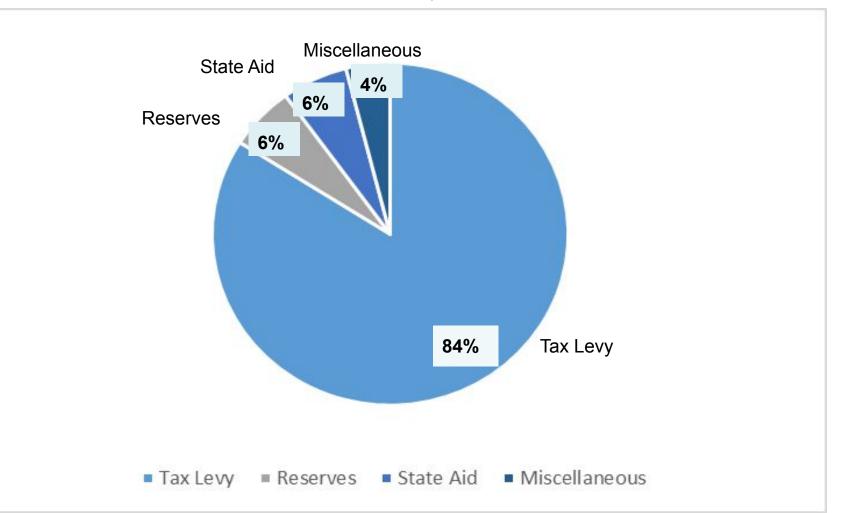
